PREK 3 & 4: BUILDING ACADEMIC AND SOCIAL FOUNDATION

Our elementary school provides a caring and safe atmosphere in which students enjoy learning and developing their unique God-given talents. Our goals for our elementary students include:

- Instill organizational skills and study habits.
- Challenge the students to integrate acquired knowledge, skills, and experience to solve problems using a variety of resources.
- Provide a robust, multi-disciplined curriculum that includes math, literacy, religion, world language, science, social studies, art, music, physical-education and STEM.



MIDDLE SCHOOL 5-8: PREPARING STUDENTS FOR TOP HIGH SCHOOLS

Our middle school program is a true high school preparatory program. Though our curriculum is rigorous and exceeds common core standards, over 60% of our students achieve honors each trimester. By the time they graduate, our middle school students will obtain the skills they need to:

- Think critically and solve complex problems.
- Work collaboratively and communicate effectively through a variety of media.
- Organize information, data, findings, and results across academic subjects
- Be prepared for High School curriculum by completing subjects including World and US History, Spanish, Algebra 1, Pre-algebra, Literature, Religion and more.



FACULTY & STAFF

Both of our campuses are staffed by a dedicated team of educators and professionals whose goal is to reach and teach each child to prepare them to thrive in the diverse and changing world that awaits them. Our staff includes:

- 2 administrators, 1 at each campus
- Full time faculty (all have advanced degrees or certifications)
- Classroom aides for grades PreK-Kindergarten
- Academic intervention teachers
- 2 counselors, 1 at each campus, to support students social and emotional needs



THE HOLY DISCIPLES EXPERIENCE

Our diverse community incorporates over 300 students from 15 different New Haven and Litchfield County towns. Each and every student has access to the following when they join as a *Holy Disciple*:

- **TECHNOLOGY:** SMARTboards in every classroom, Chromebooks and iPads, coding and digital citizenship, and usage of programs like Google classroom and Seesaw depending on their grade level.
- **ENRICHMENT:** Library and Maker Space, Innovation Lab, dedicated fine arts rooms, outdoor classrooms, instrumental instruction through CT Future Musicians, intervention assistance and programs (IXL, small groups, Wilson Foundations), academic competitions (spelling bees, MATHCOUNTS video challenge), and FRIENDZY social emotional learning program.
- **EXTRA-CURRICULARS:** JV and Varsity sports (cross country, basketball, baseball, softball), clubs for every interest (Lego, garden, craft, Caring Kids, cheerleading, drama, baking, and more!), Student Council at each campus.
- **FACILITIES:** Each campus provides access to a full size gymnasium, science lab, TV studio, and playground area/field. Each campus is also equipped with high performing security measures to provide all students and faculty a safe learning environment. Extension care is also offered for all students.
