- 1 medium-sized soft pencil case

- 1 ruler (inches and centimeters)
- 1 protractor
- 7 pocket folders (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, and black)
- 2 erasable blue or black pens
- 2 red pens (for correcting)
- 1 box of Crayola Crayons, 24 ct.
- 1 pack of Crayola Colored Pencils, 12 ct.
- 3 wide ruled composition notebooks
- 2 packs of 3x3 post-it notes
- 1 three subject spiral notebook
- 1 package of loose-leaf paper: wide-ruled
