



## Kindergarten Supply List

\*Glue Sticks- We use a lot of glue in Kindergarten! You will need to purchase several throughout the year. I have found purchasing the larger size glue sticks and buying in bulk is much easier. We will hold the extra glue sticks in school for your child.

\*Primary Pencils- These can be purchased at the school for .50 each or you can purchase them at any retail store. I would suggest buying at least 3 and keeping one at home for homework.

\*Crayons- one box 48 count (at most)

\*Pencil box- Large enough to hold all school supplies. Plastic boxes are preferred as we have found others break quite easily.

\*Safety Scissors

\*One package of fine point dry erase markers

\*Lunch box or bag

\*Backpack

\*Adult Size T-Shirt- for messy art projects

\*Folder- Please purchase the folders that have the pockets going straight across the bottom.

\*Individual Hand sanitizer for your child.

\*Baby wipes, hand soap, Kleenex, clorox wipes and paper towels (each child)

\*Small Paper plates( plain white)- Letters A-M

\*Large Paper plates( plain white)- Letters N-Z

\*\*\*\*If you would like to purchase extra of these items for your child we will have bins for each of them to hold them in so that we do not have to bother you often for new supplies

Your child's pencils, glue sticks, crayons, scissors and pencil box are needed on the first day of school. If you can have all supplies open and already in their pencil box it would be very helpful! The rest of the supplies can be brought in during the course of the first week. All supplies **EXCEPT** the backpacks, folders, and lunch boxes are to remain in school. Please inform your child as such. This helps avoid tears at dismissal time. All items need to be labeled with your child's name! The backpack, folder and homework notebooks must be brought to school every day. Many important newsletters and other correspondences are sent home daily. Thank you!
